

Animals Week – Fox Masks

Supplies:

- Mask Templates (Found in the Kit or on the linked website)
- 4 Sheets of Colored Felt Fabric (1 Orange, 1 White, 1 Black, 1 Pink)
- Cardboard
- String or Elastic (for the strap)
- Glue and Scissors

Instructions:

1. Place the main mask template on a piece of cardboard and trace the shape of it with a pencil. Then, cut the outline of the mask out of the cardboard.
2. Poke a hole into the mask on the left and right sides. Cut a long piece of string or elastic and loop it through the holes and tie it. That will be the strap for the mask.



3. Glue a piece of orange felt fabric to the cardboard mask cutout. After the glue has dried, cut the edges of the felt so that you're left with an orange mask shape.



4. Place the eyes template on a piece of white felt and trace it. After doing so, cut the shape out from the felt and glue it in place on the mask. Repeat this for both eyes.



5. Use the remaining templates to cut out shapes from the different colors of felt. Cut out 2 larger triangles in black (ears), 2 larger triangles in pink (ears again), 1 smaller triangle in black (nose), and 2 wing shapes in white (moustache) When it's all glued together, it should look like the picture below!



6. Now you have your own adorable fox mask! Bring it to the library to show us if you want!
